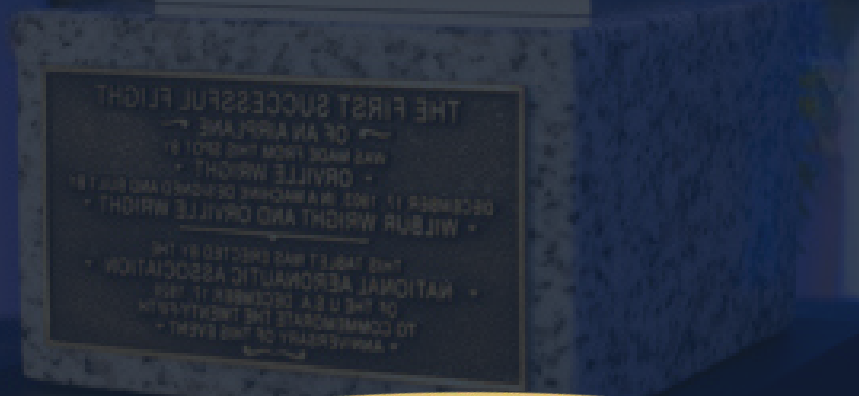

The Wright Brothers Memorial Trophy



Established by the National Aeronautic Association (NAA) in 1948 to honor the memory of Orville and Wilbur Wright, the Wright Brothers Memorial Trophy is awarded annually to a “living American for significant public service of enduring value to aviation in the United States.” The trophy is presented at the Aero Club of Washington’s Wright Memorial Dinner, held near the anniversary of powered flight.

The Wright Trophy represents a timeline of the most innovative inventors, explorers, industrialists, and public servants in aeronautics and astronautics. Past recipients include Charles Lindbergh, Igor Sikorsky, Clarence “Kelly” Johnson, Olive Ann Beech, Fred Smith, Herb Kelleher, Neil Armstrong, John Glenn, Norman Mineta, and the 2025 recipient, Joan Sullivan Garrett.

Robert Sumwalt



The Aero Club of Washington and the NAA are honored to present the 2026 Wright Brothers Memorial Trophy to Robert Sumwalt, Former Chairman of the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB).

Sumwalt's distinguished career spans 24 years as a commercial airline pilot, logging over 14,000 flight hours, followed by pioneering human factors research with NASA's Aviation Safety Reporting System. Appointed to the NTSB in 2006, he served as its 14th Chairman under multiple presidential administrations until his retirement from federal service in 2021. He currently serves as the Executive Director of the Boeing Center for Aviation and Aerospace Safety at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, continuing his lifelong mission to ensure the skies remain safe for all who fly.

Robert's visionary leadership and dedication have enhanced aviation safety for decades, permanently raised industry standards, and embodied the spirit and legacy of the Wright Brothers.
